## THE CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS FRIDAY 12 MARCH 2010 AT 18H00

### CONTEST RULES

This contest is held under the auspices of The Pipe Bands' Association of Southern Africa (PBASA) and in terms of its Contest Rules. Competitors should ensure they are completely familiar with these rules before participating in these events. Pertinent points from the Contest Rules appear below.

- Competitors participating in the Chanter contest may not participate in any other solo piping event at the gathering.
- Competitors participating in the Drum Pad contest may not participate in any other solo snare drumming event at the gathering.
- A Junior player is one who is under the age of nineteen years on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current competition year.
- The Novice events are for entry level solo competitors who satisfy the Junior definition. However, players who have learnt to play later in life and, who do not satisfy the Junior definition and, who have not previously competed in solo events, may be permitted to enter these events at the discretion of the PBASA Executive Committee.
- An Open player is one who is nineteen years, or older, on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current competition year.
- A Novice player may only play in the Novice events.
- A Junior player may play in both the Junior and Open events
- Competitors may only compete in one Piobaireachd event at the gathering.
- Competitors must appear for the events in the order stated in the Order of Play which shall be made available no less than five days before the gathering.
- Competitors who do not intend, or are unable to play in any particular event, for which they have entered, should have the courtesy of formally and timeously notifying the judges and stewards to that effect.
- It is the responsibility of all competitors to report to the stewards in good time for their particular event, failing which they will be scratched.
- Competitors and accompanying musicians should be properly dressed in correct highland uniform and the wearing of head-dress is compulsory. The wearing of golf shirts, T-shirts and caps is not permitted.
- No field entries will be allowed on the day so please ensure that all entries reach the Convenor before the closing date.
- The PBASA shall appoint a PBASA Representative to whom all queries in terms of the rules shall be referred. No verbal disputes arising out of any decision taken on the day will be entered in to. Complaints, objections and other matters relative to the competition will only be considered if they are referred in writing to the PBASA Executive Committee whose decision shall be final.

- Open to beginners of all ages.
- Competitors shall be required to play all rudimentary embellishments.

- EVENT 10 OPEN STRATHSPEY & REEL**
- Competitors shall be required to submit TWO Strathspey and Reel sets where all tunes shall comprise of at least 4 parts.
  - The judge shall select ONE Strathspey & Reel set for the competitor to play.
  - Entry Fee : R20.00
  - Prize Money : 1<sup>st</sup> : R90      2<sup>nd</sup> : R80      3<sup>rd</sup> : R70
- EVENT 11 OPEN JIG**
- Competitors shall be required to submit TWO Jigs of at least 4 parts each.
  - The judge shall select ONE Jig for the competitor to play.
  - Entry Fee : R20.00
  - Prize Money : 1<sup>st</sup> : R90      2<sup>nd</sup> : R80      3<sup>rd</sup> : R70
- EVENT 12 OPEN OVERALL WINNER**
- Results obtained in Events 9, 10, 11, and, in any Piobaireachd event shall be used to determine this prize.

- EVENT 13 NOVICE PIOBAIREACHD**
- Competitors shall be required to play the Ground of any Piobaireachd.

- EVENT 14 SILVER PIOBAIREACHD**
- Competitors shall be required to play a Piobaireachd.
  - This event is for any competitor who has not won a Piobaireachd event at the highest level eg PBASA Solo Invitationals, the 100 Guineas etc.
  - Once a competitor wins this event, the competitor is obliged to move to the Gold Piobaireachd level.
